Cosy Corners



MOTORBIKE RENEWAL MADE EASY WITH MOTS

The start of the new year is a great time to check all your important documents and schedule reminders so that you don't get caught out. I had originally used Mots' Services to help me obtain my bike licence and a recent Google Calendar alert warned me that it was due to expire. So a trip back to Soi Khao Talo to see Duncan was in order. It's a good idea not to leave things to the last minute as I did though, because I hadn't realised that you have to make two trips to the centre to renew a motorbike licence. The first trip is just to make your appointment in person and the test centre is quite a way off (near Regents School). You also need Mots' help to ensure that you have all the correct information otherwise you might find yourself having to take more than two trips.





Necessary documentation includes your passport with up to date TM30, your driving licence and 2 passport photos. After reviewing these, Duncan noticed that my licence didn't match my passport number. This was because I had recently obtained a new passport. However, it wasn't a big problem, all I had to do was provide a copy of my old passport along with all my other paperwork.

Documents checked and in order, the team at Mots then arranged a date for me to go with them to get my test appointment at the centre. This first trip only took an hour and a half from pick up at my condo to drop off back again. I noticed many people waiting at the centre but there is definitely less waiting time if you use Mots. On the second trip, I was again picked up from home and taken to the centre where I had to take a colour blindness test, a reaction time test, my photo was taken, and there was then just a short wait for the new licence to be issued.

The colour blindness test is easy; you just call out the colours that the examiner randomly displays on a test traffic light. By the time it got to my turn, I think he was bored as he shot through my colours at a really fast pace! The reaction time test was also fairly straightforward. You use two fake control pedals on the floor, one represents the accelerator, the other the brake. You press the accelerator when the light is green and then need to brake within the allocated time when the light goes to red.

I had no problem with this and did it easily on the first go. However, there was a guy after me who had big, clumpy shoes and needed several attempts because even though his reaction time was good, his big foot kept pressing down on both pedals at the same time. So you may wish to consider what footwear you wear on the day of the test and I would also recommend not wearing flip-flops as these could slip when you press the pedals.





After passing the tests, there was just a short time to wait to get my photo taken for my new license (they keep your old one). After that, you have to go to another window and pay an admin fee. Even though this is a small amount, I was grateful that Mot's had already thought about this and had money ready. Not only is this covered by your fee for their service it also means that you don't have to run off and look for an ATM if you forget to have cash on hand like me.

After just a short while, I had my new licence, which I'm delighted to say lasts until 2030, when I will choose to return to Mots again. You are in experienced hands when you use their service as they've been doing this for a long time. They have thought of everything that is likely to come up. Some of their customers require special attention, like one I heard about who was hard of hearing and another who barely spoke any English. The agent in both cases took the time to thoroughly explain the process beforehand.

I guess I'm getting on in years now and needed a little help checking over the forms to sign and making sure everything is correct. It's very reassuring to have someone with you through the entire process to help everything go smoothly. I did overhear a fellow farang with a Thai lady whose English wasn't great, and he was confused and frustrated - the air turned blue for a short while! No frustration for me though as both the Mots agents who escorted me whilst I was at the centre showed where to go and what to do. They were calm, friendly, had great English-speaking skills and understood and answered every question I had. You also enjoy VIP treatment when escorted through the centre with a Mots agent which is extremely helpful, especially when it's really busy.

When you are dropped back home with your new licence, you have peace of mind that everything has been done correctly and legally. Thinking back on this whole process, it's not just about how smoothly everything went; I also thought about how thoroughly nice everyone is who works for Mots. They actually managed to make all this enjoyable and we shared a few laughs along the way. I like to use people that I really like, and it's a pleasure to give them my business; it's worth every baht. Once you've used them, you won't want to go with anyone else.

My recent trip to Palawan was a total eye-opener-I now completely get why this place has been racking up global compliments. While it's not as well-known as some of the big-name island destinations around the world (yet!), it's clear this little gem is on its way to stardom. One of the absolute highlights of my trip was staying at the Fight Club Resort Fitness Resort in Puerto Princesa. Here's the deal: my cousin and I are big into fitness, and we thought, "Why not mix some Muay Thai training into our tropical getaway? " Best. Decision. Ever. Not only did we fuel up with nutritious, mouthwatering meals, but we also met the most amazing people from all over the world. Every meal turned into a mini celebration, filled with laughter and stories. And the portions? Perfect. The accommodations were just as awesome. My cousin and I opted for the dorms, and they were super clean and comfy. Lockers, toiletry kits-they thought of everything. And after a long day of training, the massages were the cherry on top of an already incredible day. For us who were looking for a refreshing, fitness-fueled retreat that also feels like a mini adventure, Fight Club Resort was definitely the place to be.



A trip to Palawan wouldn't be complete without diving into the magic of El Nido's Iconic Island Tours. Exploring the enchanting Secret Lagoon is like stepping into a different world. Tucked behind a tiny rock wall on Miniloc Island, you squeeze through a little opening and suddenly, you're surrounded by towering limestone cliffs that make you feel tiny in the best way. The cooler temperature and magical views of the blue sky peeking through the cliffs create a peaceful escape. Just outside, the Secret Beach is a postcard-perfect haven with white sand, swaying coconut trees, and crystal-clear waters teeming with colorful fish-ideal for snorkeling or simply soaking in the beauty. Then there's the Big Lagoon which was an absolute showstopper. Imagine paddling through water so blue and clear, with towering karst cliffs covered in greenery on both sides. The nearly kilometer-long lagoon is dreamy beyond words. We even squeezed through watery tunnels in our kayak, barely fitting between the limestone walls—it was part adventure, part jaw-dropping scenery.



One of our most surreal experiences in Palawan was at The Puerto Princesa Subterranean River National Park. It felt like stepping into another world entirely. Imagine this: floating along a winding underground river, surrounded by towering limestone caves dripping with stalactites and stalagmites. It was like nature decided to put on its own art exhibit! Here's how it went: We climbed into a small boat and were handed audio devices to guide us through the experience. As we drifted into the mouth of the cave, we felt the world outside disappeared. The audio guide was super informative about the cave's history, sharing cool tidbits about the incredible formations we were seeing: some were shaped like fruits, veggies, church figures, and even The Last Supper!

The boat guide kept it fun and interactive, he pointed out the must-see spots, and made sure we didn't miss anything. But there was one strict rule: absolute silence. Why? Because the cave is home to bats, and they rely on echolocation to get around. So there we were, gliding silently through the dark, with only the soft sound of water dripping and bats squeaking overhead. It felt like being in a secret world that only a lucky few get to see. At times, I won't lie, the eerie stillness was a bit creepy (hello, bats and darkness!). But overall, the whole experience was simply breathtaking.

Finally, I would like to mention one of the coolest places we stayed in El Nido-Domes and Dreams in Lio. Glamping probably isn't the first thing you think of in Palawan, but trust me, this was next-level amazing. These chic geodesic domes were pure luxury, complete with comfy beds, a private garden, and an open-roof shower where you can bathe under the stars. They really nailed it with the details-AC, Starlink-powered WiFi, tea and coffee, a hairdryer, charging ports by the bed-you name it. Everything was spotless, the location was peaceful yet close to the action, and the staff were super welcoming. If you're heading to El Nido, this gem is a must-try. Palawan is pure magic, from its epic lagoons to dreamy stays-it's the kind of place that makes you never want to leave!

Winfield, Kansas USAs Where Bluegrass Music is #1

(Walnut Valley Festival: Not a secret anymore)

The magical, old-fashioned town of Winfield has celebrated over 150 years since its founding and now hosts over 12,000 people at its annual bluegrass music festival event. It started over 50 years ago, originally just to host a guitar competition, but has kept growing yearly. "Happy Winfield!" was the greeting we heard often, usually with a hug, at one of our favorite festivals: the Walnut Valley Festival. This open-air music festival is located along the beautiful Walnut River of Winfield in Kansas (the center-most state of the United States). Many people go every year, even flying around the world for it as we did - all the way from Thailand! It has a huge campground with many zones, making up communities of campers that have fun rituals such as fancy dress, barbecue cook-offs, even offering cocktails to people passing by and eating together by the camp fire. They jam into the night. Someone starts a song and the rest follow and play or sing along.

Everyone is happy to be in "Pickers Paradise," a nickname for the festival. People are genuinely happy and friendly, and pop-up performances in the campgrounds are plentiful. There are eight contest stages with international competitions for a variety of instruments such as autoharp, guitar, fiddle, banjo and mandolin. Once you've been to this Winfield festival, it's normal that you always want to go back, no matter how far away you are. It's like home to many who attend. "If you don't go, you don't know," says one "bluegrasser" and old-time style musician Arch Stanton, who did clogging (a type of dance) and played percussion instruments in Catgut String Band.



Bluegrass is a particular form of American music that you hear a lot of at the Walnut Valley Festival. It can be fast and peppy, or slow and moody with songs that tell stories, happy, or sometimes sad. Musicians here know the bluegrass standard tunes by heart e.g. "Playing it by ear" and also play American cowboy music, gospel, folk, Western swing or even Celtic music. The National Flat-Picking Guitar Championship and autoharp contest draw highly-skilled contestants.



Recent festival entertainers include Bing Futch (mountain dulcimer, ukulele and Native American flute), Bebe Gambetta, The Haymakers band, Crying Uncle Bluegrass Band, the Rick Farris Band, Front Porch, Becky Buller, Barry Patton, Rob Ickes and Trey Hensley, John McCutcheon, Linda Tilton (on ukulele), Socks in the Frying Pan, The Steel Wheels band, The Tina Bergmann and Bryan Thomas duo and Little Big Twang.

We really like local Kansas bands: 80 Proof Alice, Pretend Friend, and Dead End Strings. Some big names who got their start here are Doc Watson, Dixie Chicks, Byron Berline, and Alison Krauss. Allison Krauss first had a hit with the song "When You Say Nothing At All," which was famously covered by Ronan Keating for the movie Notting Hill movie and which we all sang along with when he headlined the Pattaya International Jazz Festival last month.



We spent one evening on comfortable camping chairs, eating delicious homemade food while fiddlers and guitar players walked by and stopped to serenade us with songs. Our nostalgic memories go way back with the Walnut Valley Festival. We went to it when Jason was a little boy. It's a big "music party," and people roam around the festival to listen at the varied stages.

You can also find arts and crafts booths, food and drink vendors and places to buy gear and musical instruments. Some visitors just come for the day, others attend the four-day event Thursday through Sunday. On Friday and Saturday, there is a music camp for children and also Feisty Kids Camp with plenty of activities.

Winfield's Walnut Valley Festival is professionally-run, quirky and has unusual fancy dress parades.. Motels get booked up early, but some attendees find accommodation in Wichita or Ark City, but a lot of the fun is staying onsite, waking up in Winfield, drinking coffee and eating breakfast listening to the music.



We joined our cousins Jonathan and Suzanne who have their own golf cart but these can also be rented to roam around the festival. One night it came in handy for the Rupp cousins to watch the movie "O Brother Where Art Thou" which famously stars George Clooney and features bluegrass music. It is shown annually on Stage 5 in Pecan Grove.



The Walnut Valley Association office is on Main Street Winfield and the festival website (wvfest.com) includes great information. Plus you can follow the Facebook groups of Walnut Valley Festival and Walnut Valley Bluegrass Festival Fans. The new official 53rd Walnut Valley Festival dates are Sept. 17-21, 2025. So plan ahead, come a few days early and remember you don't need to play an instrument to have fun – it just helps to be music lovers as we are. How would you describe the current demand for property in the local market? Local Realtors Survey Result

Nineteen realtors who have listings on the local listing website www.pattayapropertyguide.com recently took part in a survey about the local Pattaya market. Here are the results. It should be noted that the survey was conducted in October before the USA Presidential result.

How would you describe the current demand for property in the local market? 18% said high however the majority (82%) Siad moderate.

What type of properties are selling the fastest in the current market? 9% said land, 18% luxury villas, while 73% said condominiums.

What are the biggest challenges buyers are facing currently? 20% said competition from other buyers, while 30% said affordability however the biggest (50%) quoted Limited inventory of stock.

How would you describe the average time a property stays on the market before it sells? 9% said less than 30 days, 18% said 30-60 days 18% 60-90 days and 55% over 90 days.

Which price range of homes is seeing the most activity in the local market? 9% said below THB3million, 64% said from THB4-9million while only 27% said THB10-25million.

What are the main factors driving property price changes in the local market? 18% stated Government policies, 18% said economic conditions and the majority 64% said supply and demand.

Have the recent interest rate changes impacted the local market? 9% it had significantly slowed it down, 9% said it had slowed it down slightly however the majority (82% said it had had no impact.

What type of demographic is the most active in the current market? 10% were retirees, 20% were first time buyers and 70% were investors.

How do you expect property values in the local market to trend over the next year? 36% said they expect values to remain stable while 64% expected a slight increase.

What is the current ratio of Thai to Foreign buyers in your local market? 45% said an even mix of Thais and Foreigners while 55% said mainly foreigners.

Where are majority of Thai buyers based? 27% were from local eastern seaboard, 36% from Bangkok and 36^ were Overseas Thai expats.

Among foreign buyers which nationality is most common in the local market? 9% Chinese 18% American, India, Arab, Japanese and Korean and 73% were European (British, German and French).

What type of property age are your buyers interested in? 27% on new developments (off plan), 27% recently completed less than 5 years, and 46^ from 5-10 years old.
